The 2008 LAAC Family Law Awards will be presented to three family law advocates in recognition of their outstanding dedication and commitment to legal services for low-income Californians. One award will be given to an advocate who has demonstrated exemplary service to low-income clients in family law in each of the following categories:

- I. Direct representation (Legal Services Family Attorney)
- II. Pro Bono Work (Private Attorney)
- III. Family Law Facilitator or Self-Help Center Service Provider

The LAAC Recognition Committee will review the nominations and make final selections. For this special award, the committee will consider the nominee's contributions in one or more of the following areas:

1. Demonstrated commitment to the delivery of direct legal services to the poor in family law;
2. Successful cases that had a significant impact on legal services family law clients;
3. Work with the family law client community that increased client access to legal services;
4. Activity that enhanced the delivery of legal services to family law clients.

All LAAC organizational and individual members and members of the LAAC Family Law Training Committee are eligible to make award nominations.
